Day I Australia - Negombo - Welcome to sunny Sri Lanka, the teardropshaped island in the middle of the Indian Ocean. On arrival you will be met and transferred to your hotel.

Day 2 Negombo - Take this morning to relax and unwind after your flight. In the afternoon we enjoy a city tour of Negombo, once a trading port for the Portuguese and Dutch, followed by an evening boat ride on the Gin Oya River. For dinner we enjoy a group welcome barbecue set up by a local family. [B,D]

Day 3 Negombo - Sigiriya - SPECIAL EXPERIENCE: An amazing morning as we visit one of Sri Lanka's major attractions, the world famous Pinnawela Elephant Orphanage. After a big feed, the elephants are led to the local river for a bath and a refreshing swim. This is a great chance to take some up-close photos! We then head to Sigiriya, arriving in the early evening. [B,D]

Day 4 Anuradhapura - A fascinating morning as we visit the spectacular ruins of ancient Anuradhapura, a UNESCO World Heritage site. We then travel back to Sigiriya via the Ritigala Medicinal Forest, an incredibly beautiful and mystical place rarely visited by tourists. [B,D]

Day 5 Polonnaruwa - Minneriya - Today we visit the ancient capital of Polonnaruwa before a visit to the Minneriya National Park. Here you can observe the elephants and the huge flocks of birds that come to fish in the shallow waters. [B,D]

Day 6 Sigiriya - A must-see in Sri Lanka is the famous rock fortress and palace of Sigiriya, set amongst beautiful gardens. This amazing ancient monument is considered one of the wonders of the world. This afternoon we learn about daily Sri Lankan life as we meet the locals in a small rural village. [B,L,D]

Day 7 Sigiriya - Kandy - After breakfast we make our way to Kandy via the surreal cave temple of Dambulla, home to statues and paintings telling of Lord Buddha and his life.We then enjoy the vivid colours and enticing aromas of the Matale spice plantations before continuing to Kandy to see the Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic, one of the most important sites of the Buddhist religion. [B]

Day 8 Kandy - We start the day in the stunning Royal Botanical Gardens of Peradeniya, which are famous for their

collection of orchids and wide variety of plant species. We then continue with a tour of the city including a visit to its impressive historical museum. The day ends with a dazzling performance by local dancers and a mesmerising Sri Lankan fire walk demonstration. [B]

Day 9 Kandy - Nuwara Eliya - Our journey takes us by scenic local train up to the lush tea-growing region of Nuwara Eliya, home of the famous Ceylon tea. We visit a tea plantation and factory to learn all about the tea-making process, and try a few of the local brews! [B,D]

Day 10 Nuwara Eliya - Today we tour Nuwara Eliya and also visit the stunning sights of St Clair and Devon Falls. [B]

Day II Nuwara Eliya - Tissamaharama - A beautiful scenic drive through the mountains takes us to the coast to Tissamaharama, the gateway to Yala National Park. Along the way we have the opportunity to visit the spectacular Ella Waterfalls. [B,D]

Day 12 Yala National Park - Today is all about animals and nature as we go on safari in Yala National Park. Here we can spot leopards, elephants, buffalo and black bears. [B,D]

Day I3 Tissamaharama - Galle - Hikkaduwa -We drive along the beautiful south coast of Sri Lanka before arriving at the coastal town of Galle. Here we take a guided tour of this great walled city before making our way to Hikkaduwa, a stunning town famous for its beach, surfing and coral. [B,D]

Day 14 Hikkaduwa - We start the day with a scenic cruise along the Madu River before visiting the Moonstone Mine, one of the few places where the semi-precious stone is found. This afternoon we return to our hotel to enjoy the sun, sea and sand. [B,D]

Day 15 Hikkaduwa - Colombo - We journey to Colombo and en route visit Kosgoda turtle hatchery. Upon arrival in Colombo we take a city tour and also pay a visit to the popular Cricket Club Cafe, run by two Australians. Tonight we enjoy a group farewell dinner. [B,D]

Day 16 Depart Colombo - Enjoy a day at leisure to relax by the pool or do some last-minute shopping before we transfer to the airport for our late flight home. [B]

Tour Negombo and Pinnawela Elephant Orphanage


- Observe the true life of Negombo at the local fish markets
