This is the perfect itinerary for those with limited time. Game drive through the famous Serengeti and Masai Mara, savour the rich wildlife and bird spectacle of Lake Nakuru, and enjoy the colourful village life of Masai natives. Experience the rich culture of these lands by visiting local homes and markets in Mto Wa Abu, an authentic Tanzanian village and a colourful Masai Mara village where you will enjoy traditional dancing.



**DAY I DEPART AUSTRALIA** - Depart Australia for your African adventure.

**DAY 2 ARRIVE IN NAIROBI** - Welcome to Nairobi. On our arrival we will be met and transferred to our hotel. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure before this evening's group welcome dinner. [D]

**DAY 3 NAIROBI - TARANGIRE** - After breakfast we depart for Tanzania, then enjoy an afternoon game drive at Tarangire National Park, famous for its huge number of elephants, baobab trees and tree-climbing lions. [B,L,D]

**DAY 4 TARANGIRE - LAKE MANYARA** - It's all about animals this morning as we continue to explore the Tarangire National Park in search of impala, eland, kadu, buffalo and the hundreds of bird species that inhabit the area. [B,L,D]

SPECIAL EXPERIENCE: Delight in a unique taste of Tanzanian culture as we visit local homes and markets at Mto Wa Mbu, an authentic Tanzanian village. Enjoy a delicious traditional lunch prepared by locals.

**DAY 5 LAKE MANYARA - SERENGETI** - This morning we journey towards the sweeping plains of the Serengeti via Olduvai Gorge, home to world-renowned archaeological finds. This afternoon experience local wildlife on a game drive of the Serengeti, known for its high density of predators and prey. [B,L,D]

**DAY 6 SERENGETI** - Today is all about the spectacular Serengeti as we enjoy fantastic morning and afternoon game drives. The landscape of the Serengeti is characterised by treeless plains which we will explore in search of big cats, gazelle, zebra and other wildlife. [B,L,D]

**DAY 7 SERENGETI - NGORONGORO** - Enjoy a morning game drive before heading east to the famous Ngorongoro Crater. Along the way we keep an eye out for wildlife and Masai herding cattle. The crater, a UNESCO World Heritage site, was created by the implosion of a massive volcano and is a virtual game park in its own right as it's home to many game species. [B,L,D]

**DAY 8 NGORONGORO CRATER** - SPECIAL EXPERIENCE: Today's game drive is unique as we descend to the floor of the Ngorongoro Crater against a spectacular backdrop of forest-covered crater walls. Witness abundant wildlife including wildebeest, zebra, elephants and hippos as we explore Lerai Forest. [B,L,D]

**DAY 9 NGORONGORO - AMBOSELI** - Our touring today takes us to Amboseli National Park which has Africa's highest mountain, Mt. Kilimanjaro, as a backdrop. This area is also home to the nomadic Masai warriors, known for their legendary bravery. [B,L,D]

**DAY 10 AMBOSELI** - Enjoy game drives in the Amboseli National Park, famous for its elephant population and more than 400 species of birds. The rich wildlife framed against Mt. Kilimanjaro's snow-covered mountains make this a photographer's paradise. [B,L,D]

**DAY II AMBOSELI - LAKE NAIVASHA** - We travel to the magnificent Lake Naivasha via Nairobi. This lake is the highest (and one of the most beautiful!) lakes which dot the Great Rift Valley. A popular stop for British flying boats of the 1930s, its rich heritage and idyllic scenery make it the perfect place to relax. [B,L,D]

**DAY 12 LAKE NAIVASHA** - Today starts with a scenic boat tour of Lake Naivasha followed by an island walking tour. Later we enjoy tea at Elsamere - former home of Joy Adamson, author of the famous novel "Born Free". The remainder of the day is at leisure. [B,L,D]

**DAY 13 LAKE NAIVASHA - NAKURU** - Today we travel to beautiful Lake Nakuru National Park, where we enjoy an afternoon game drive. This park is home to many game including rhino and buffalo and is famous for its diverse birdlife including graceful pink flamingos. [B,L,D]

**DAY 14 NAKURU - MASAI MARA** - The jewel in Africa's crown, the Masai Mara is home to the most spectacular array of wildlife. Here we'll enjoy a game drive through the rolling grasslands in search of lions. The Masai Mara is believed to have one of the highest lion densities in Africa. [B,L,D]

**DAY 15 MASAI MARA** - Today we enjoy a final game drive through the incredible open savannas that make up the magnificent Masai Mara. Later we visit a colourful Masai village where we enjoy traditional dancing and learn more about their unique culture. [B,L,D]

SPECIAL EXPERIENCE: A real highlight today as we explore Masai Mara's vast plains, famous for their exceptional population of game, and the annual "Great Migration".

**DAY 16 MASAI MARA - NAIROBI** - Our Masai Mara experience comes to an end today as we journey back to Nairobi. On arrival enjoy time at leisure before tonight's group farewell dinner at a local restaurant which offers authentic Kenyan cuisine. [B,D]

**DAY 17 DEPART NAIROBI** - This morning we enjoy an interesting city tour visiting the National Museum and Snake Park. The Snake Park provides shelter for rescued reptiles as well as being a centre for education and research. Later we transfer to the airport to begin our journey home. [B]


