Day I Depart Australia

- **Day 2 Arrive in Istanbul** Welcome to Istanbul, the gateway between Asia and Europe. This evening we enjoy a delightful welcome dinner. [D]

- **Day 6 Cappadocia** The lunar-like landscape of Cappadocia will amaze you.[B,D]
- SPECIAL EXPERIENCE: We explore this fascinating region with its 'fairy chimneys' and the nearby Goreme Valley. We also visit a carpet factory to learn about Turkish carpets before tonight's impressive performance by the Whirling Dervishes.
- **Day 7 Cappadocia** This morning we explore one of the underground cities of Cappadocia before continuing on to the small village of Avanos which is famous for its ceramics. [B,D]
- **Day 8 Cappadocia Konya** On the way to Konya we explore the Catalhoyuk, a Neolithic site where the various art works include spectacular wall paintings. In Konya we visit the Mevlana Museum and learn about the mystical religious sect known as the Whirling Dervishes. [B,D]
- **Day 9 Konya Kas** Enjoy a scenic day as we drive to Kas via Aspendos where we explore one of the world's best-preserved Roman theatres. [B]
- **Day 10 Kas** Today is all about relaxing, soaking up the sun and the spectacular coastal scenery. [B,L]
- SPECIAL EXPERIENCE: A real tour highlight as we cruise the sparkling Mediterranean on a traditional Turkish gulet.

- **Day II Kas Pamukkale** This morning we explore the amazing landscape of Hierapolis, an ancient Greek city sitting on top of the site of Pamukkale. Over a period of 14,000 years, nature has created a wonderful array of hot springs that cascade over a cliff, forming calcium-rich pools. [B,D]
- **Day 12 Pamukkale Bodrum** Today we explore the town of Aphrodisias, named after Aphrodite, the god of love and often referred to as Venus by the Romans. This beautiful city is one of the finest archaeological sites in Turkey and is famous for its School of Sculpture which dates back to Roman times. [B]
- **Day 13 Bodrum** Bring your bathers today as we enjoy a half-day tour of the Museum of Underwater Archaeology, home to the remains of the oldest known sunken ship in the world (we're only joking about the bathers!). The rest of the day is at leisure. [B]
- **Day 14 Bodrum Kusadasi** An action-packed day as we visit the three archaeological sites of Miletus and Didyma, before driving on to historic Kusadasi. [B]
- **Day 15 Ephesus** A wonderful day of antiquity as we visit Ephesus, the largest Roman city ever uncovered and a great place to get a feel for what life was like at the time of the Romans. As we walk down the marblecovered streets, we'll see gymnasiums, bathhouses, the Temple of Artemis and the House of Virgin Mary. [B,D]
- **Day 16 Kusadasi Canakkale** Today we visit the ancient city of Pergamum, once ruled by Alexander the Great. We then continue on to Troy, where we experience the legend of the famous wooden horse. [B,D]
- **Day 17 Gallipoli Istanbul** A special day as we head to Gallipoli to pay homage to the great Australian and New Zealand spirit of the Anzacs. Visit Anzac Cove, the Lone Pine Memorial and spend time exploring the Turkish and Allied trenches and tunnels. [B]
- **Day 18 Istanbul** We've come full circle and are now back in bustling Istanbul where there is still so much to see. Our touring includes: The Grand and Spice Bazaars for some great people-watching and last minute shopping. Tonight we enjoy a farewell dinner. [B,D]
- **Day 19 Depart Istanbul** Today we begin our journey home. [B]
