Day 1 Depart Australia - Your tour begins! Depending on your departure city you will either have a night in Asia before connecting to Hanoi or an overnight flight to Hanoi.

Day 2 Arrive in Hanoi - On our arrival we will be transferred to our hotel, where the afternoon is at leisure to re-energise before tonight's group welcome dinner. [D]

Day 3 Hanoi - SPECIAL EXPERIENCE: This morning we enjoy a traditional tai chi class at Hoan Kiem Lake before taking a city tour of Hanoi. Our touring includes the One Pillar Pagoda, Temple of Literature and the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum. We finish with a walking tour around the Old Quarter. [B]

Day 4 Hanoi - Hoa Binh - Hanoi - A fascinating day as we head into the hills of Hoa Binh Province. We visit the Muong village of Giang Mo, a small village of traditional stilt houses, nestled among rice paddies and rolling hills. Here we enjoy a traditional dance performance before returning to Hanoi. [B]

Day 5 Hanoi - Halong Bay - Bring your cameras today as we head for the water wonderland of Halong Bay. On arrival we board our junk boat, home for the night, where we are served a delicious seafood lunch before setting sail.

SPECIAL EXPERIENCE: Cruise the water wonderland that is Halong Bay onboard a traditional junk boat. The beautiful landscapes are amazing and the seafood is out of this world! [B,L,D]

Day 6 Halong Bay - Hanoi - Hoi An - Sit back and relax this morning as we continue to cruise Halong Bay. We enjoy close up views of the stunning limestone peaks as well as a visit to the tranquil Luon Cave. Later we sail past many floating villages where you can see the local fishermen cast their nets. After lunch we fly to Danang and then make the short drive to Hoi An. [B,L]

Day 7 Hoi An - A fun-filled morning as we explore the cobblestone streets of old Hoi An by foot. This afternoon we enjoy a traditional Vietnamese cooking class. [B,D]

Day 8 Hoi An - Enjoy a day at leisure to explore the

charming old town, relax by the pool or take advantage of the low-cost local tailoring. [B]

Day 9 Hoi An - danang - hue - On our way to Hue we drive through scenic mountain ranges via the stunning Hai Van Pass, a beautiful oceanside mountain pass (name means 'ocean clouds'). Once at Hue we enjoy a tour of this vibrant city including the palaces of the old Imperial City and the tombs of Tu Doc and Khai Dinh. [B,L]

Day 10 Hue - Saigon - An early start this morning as we fly to Saigon, formerly known as 'Ho Chi Minh City'. The largest city in Vietnam, Saigon is a place where the old seamlessly blends with the new. Our sightseeing here includes the City Hall, Emperor of Jade Pagoda, War Remnants Museum and the Notre Dame Cathedral. [B]

Day 11 Saigon - An interesting day as we travel by speedboat to the remarkable Cu Chi tunnels. A remnant of the Vietnam War, this incredible underground network stretches more than 200km. Tonight we enjoy a group dinner at the famous Rex Hotel. [B,L,D]

Day 12 Saigon - Mekong Delta - Today we travel to the Mekong Delta where we board our boat for a trip on the Mekong River to Ben Tre. This beautiful city is known for its handmade crafts, and sweets made from coconut. We then take a short ride on a horse-drawn carriage and in small sampan boats to observe the local daily life. [B]

Day 13 Mekong Delta - Chau Doc - This morning we'll catch all the action of the Cai Rang Floating Market, the most lively market in the Delta. We then continue on to Chau Doc where we climb to the top of Sam Mountain for a fantastic view all the way to the Cambodian border. [B]

Day 14 Chau Doc - Phnom Penh - Today we travel by speedboat from Vietnam to Cambodia. In Phnom Penh we take a city tour including the Royal Palace and the National Museum. [B]

Day 15 Phnom Penh - This morning we take a moving visit to the "killing fields" including Tuol Sleng and its museum. The rest of the day is at leisure. [B]

Day 16 Phnom Penh - Siem Reap - We fly to Siem Reap to begin our sightseeing of the magnificent Angkor Wat temple complex. [B] SPECIAL EXPERIENCE: Tonight we'll watch the sunset from one of the upper terraces of an ancient temple - a truly unforgettable experience!

Day 17 Angkor Wat - Angkor Wat is a real highlight of this tour and today we further explore this temple complex including the Terrace of the Elephants and Ta Prohm. The temples are still partially covered by jungle and look much the same as when they were first discovered. Tonight we enjoy a group farewell dinner at a local restaurant. [B,D]

Day 18 Depart Siem Reap - This morning enjoy an excursion to the beautiful Tonle Sap Lake. We take a ride along the canal passing the Cambodian locals and their stilt houses on the banks, before we begin our journey home. [B]

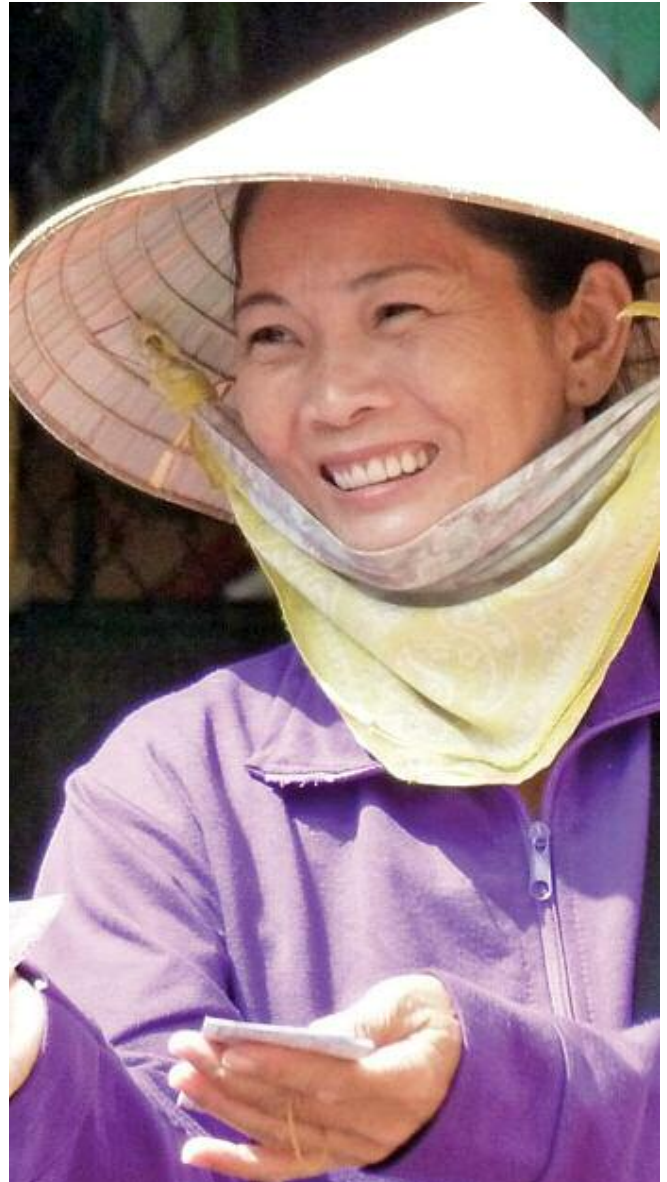
